Both cars had severe impact, and Mary was casted-off through the windscreen. Fortunately, she was carried urgency to a hospital near by that place, but her case required special medical cares. The only part of her body that she could move was her head.

In this way, the Health Minister talked with "Light into Europe" in

Bucharest, so that, in 2000, Stan and Camelia Platt with their team started on finding solutions for this unhappy case. After the first surgical intervention in Bucharest, more over the plains of Mary for the recovery, now she is capable to move also her arms. Last days, Mary was in Nottingham (with Mr. Stan, the President of "Light into Europe") for new medical visits, and now, Mary is in England waiting the results. We wish you health, Mary!!!
